Key Responsibilities

These include:

(a) Personal Data Privacy & Protection Work

- Advise business units on personal data privacy and protection matters, including legal risks and/or implications of business decisions;
- Draft, review and negotiate personal data protection clauses, data processing agreements/templates, privacy notices, etc;
- Work with business units to evaluate, implement and monitor internal personal data protection compliance policies, procedures, controls and/or remediation measures, as may be needed from time to time;
- Review regularly the Company's procedures, practices and documents to identify possible weaknesses and risks;
- Review, develop and oversee the Company's policies on data privacy and protection;
- Implement and manage the legal compliance programmes to mitigate risks; and
- Provide personal data protection training to relevant employees.

(b) Other Compliance Work

- Advise business units on compliance and ethics issues;
- Provide legal support to compliance-related disputes and investigations;
- Review and advise on legal and contractual matters.

Requirements
